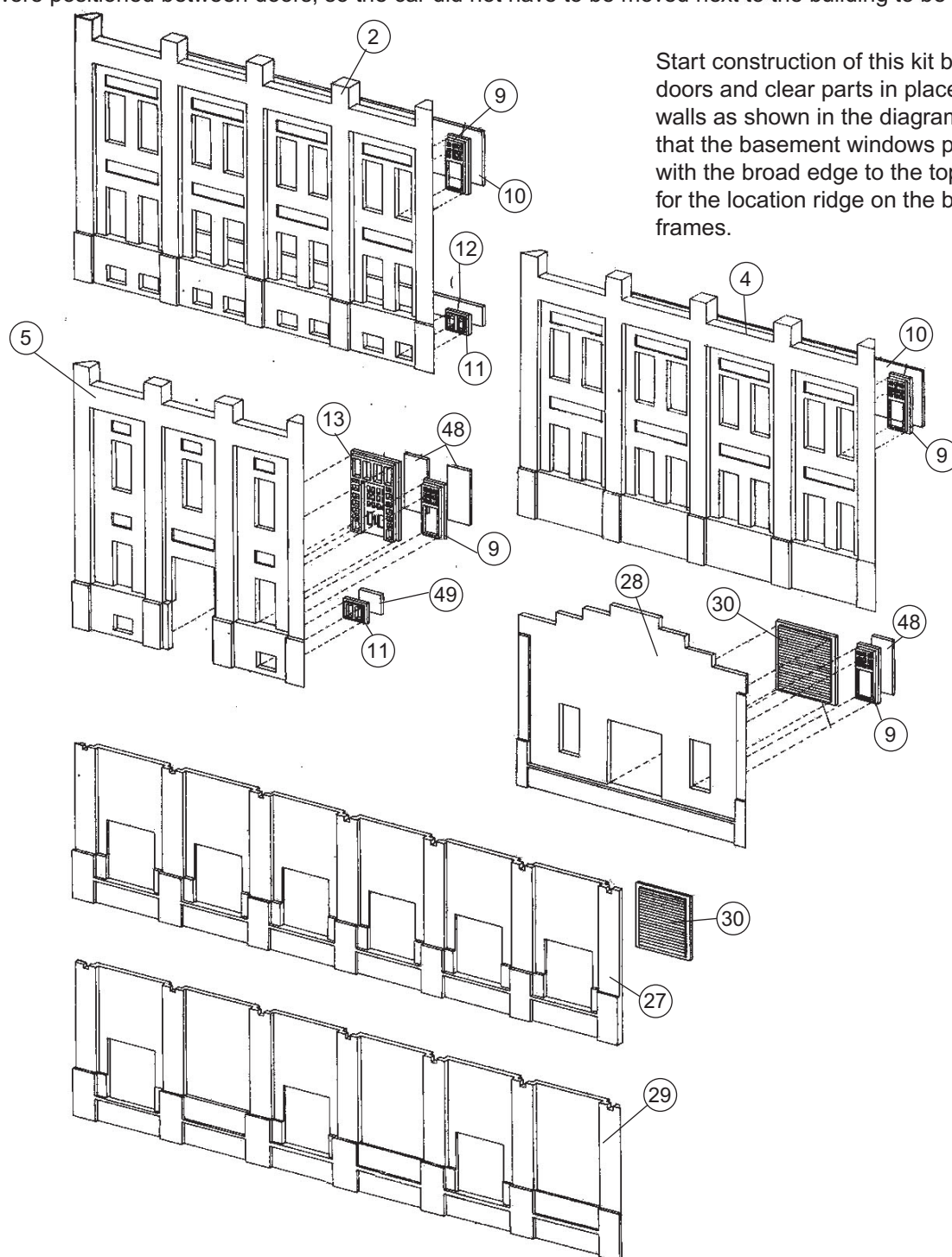




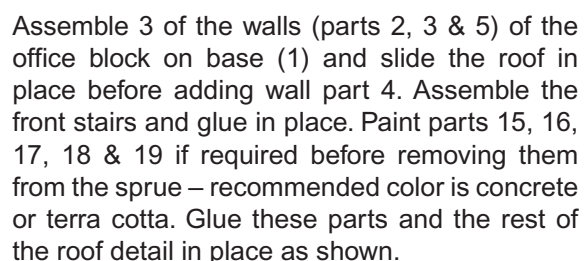
N Structure Kit WATER STREET FREIGHT TERMINAL 933-3201

Thanks for purchasing this structure! The finished model is a detailed replica of a typical Freight Terminal which fits in many time periods. All parts in this kit are made of styrene plastic. Uses only glues and paints which are plastic compatible.

Freight terminals were once essential to railroad operations, handling small, less-than-carload lot (LCL) freight shipments. Loads arrived in box cars or refrigerated cars and were transferred to a fleet of trucks for local delivery. The trucks would also pick up freight which was to be shipped by rail. Each railroad serving a community had its own freight terminal, usually located near the main passenger station or classification yard, so several of these kits can be used on your layout. A typical freight house would be served by two or more parallel tracks. Cars were spotted side by side and metal bridge plates were positioned between doors, so the car did not have to be moved next to the building to be loaded or unloaded.



Start construction of this kit by gluing all windows, doors and clear parts in place on the respective walls as shown in the diagrams. NOTE: Make sure that the basement windows parts 11 are placed with the broad edge to the top so that there is room for the location ridge on the base under the window frames.



1. After cutting out the decal, dip in water for 10 seconds, remove and let stand for 1 minute. Slide decal onto surface, position and then blot off any excess water.
2. Lightly brush Micro Sol® on top. This will soften the decal allowing it to conform to irregular surfaces. **DO NOT TOUCH DECAL** while wet!
3. When the decal is thoroughly dry, check for any trapped air bubbles. Prick them with the point of a small pin or hobby knife blade and apply more Micro Sol®.

Assemble the 4 walls of the warehouse – parts 27,28,29& 31 on base 41. Paint truss parts 32, 35 & 36 green before removing from the sprue, then glue in place as shown. Note that parts 35 are placed on wall 29 and parts 36 on wall 27. Glue
