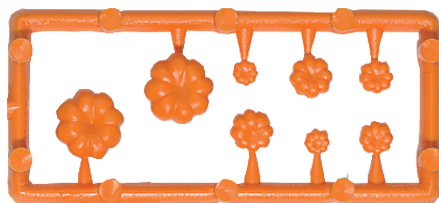

PUMPKIN PATCH
949-1115

Thanks for purchasing this Walther's SceneMaster kit, which can be used to model a small pumpkin patch by itself, or to add additional plants to the Vegetable Garden (#949-1110) or Overgrown Garden (#949-1117; both sold separately). Please read these instructions and study the drawings before starting. Parts are made of styrene plastic, so use compatible glue and paint to assemble and finish your model as noted. The various parts can be arranged as desired; the instruction and box photos show typical examples. Individual parts are not numbered; please refer to the sprue layout to identify parts. Tools

All-purpose adhesive ♦ Sharp hobby knife or sprue cutter ♦ Tweezers ♦ Acrylic paint ♦ Ground foam

1) If you will be adding your finished patch to a new or existing scene, you may wish to prepare the area ahead of time with soil, weeds or other ground-cover (sold separately). These illustrations show a typical assembly.

2) For best results, use a new blade and carefully cut Vines from sprues. Once removed, bend leaves upward into various positions using a tweezers.

3) Drill or poke small mounting holes into your layout surface. Arrange three Vines in a Y-shape as shown; dip the plain end into all-purpose adhesive and insert ends into holes.

4) Remove pumpkins from sprue. Apply a bit of glue to your layout surface and set the pumpkins in place beside and under the vines as shown.
