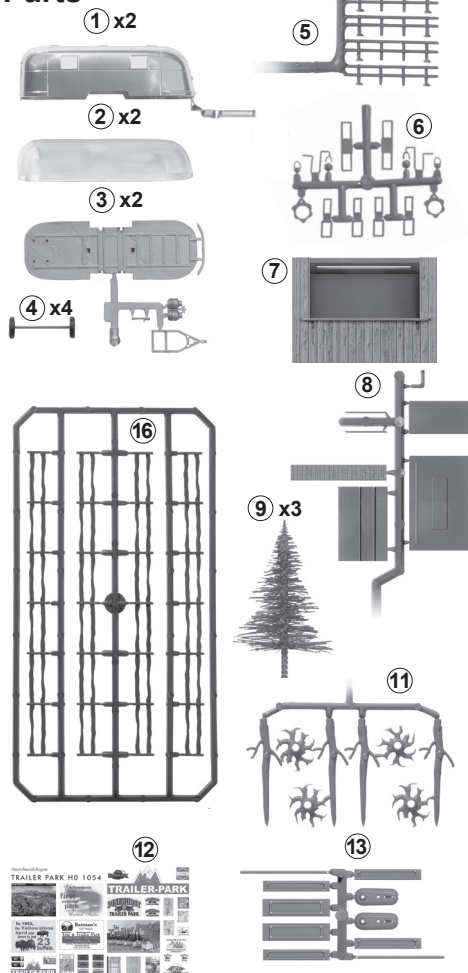


HO SCALE

WITH TRAILERS**

Thanks for purchasing this Walther's SceneMaster kit. Please read these instructions and study the drawings before starting. All plastic parts are styrene so use compatible glue and paint to assemble and finish your models. Some additional parts are included that are not used in construction; keep them for future projects or discard them as desired.

Parts

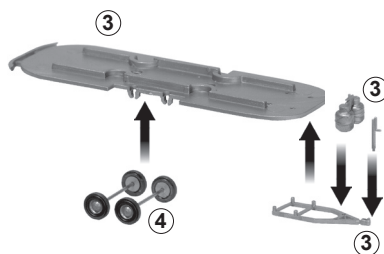


Trailer Assembly *(Makes 2 Trailers)*

1) Insert Glass (2) into Body (1) as shown.



2) Insert four pins on Tow Bar in openings at front of Chassis and glue in place. Carefully trim Propane Tanks from sprue to avoid damaging mounting pins on bottom; insert pins into openings on top of Tow Bar and glue in place. PLEASE NOTE: The handle is the top of the Jack; this fits the opening in the Tow Bar, but can be installed in either the down (parked) or up (towing, vehicle not included) position as desired. Snap wheel assemblies (2x 4) into center openings on Chassis.

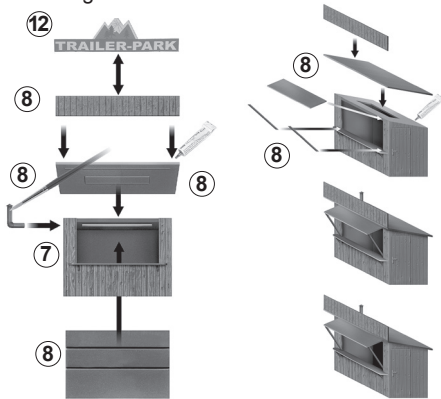


3) Insert completed Chassis into Body.



Office Assembly

- 1) Glue Interior Wall to rear wall of Office.
- 2) Note raised area on Roof fits opening on Office and glue in place. Glue Plastic Sign to Roof.
- 3) Tip-Out can be built opened or closed: for a closed model, glue to inset area between openings in front wall and counter. For open version, glue to inset area between openings in front wall; glue one angled end of each Brace to the outside top edge of Tip-Out. Glue top of Tip-Out to top of opening and bottom edges of Braces to front wall. Smokejack may be glued to side or rear wall as desired. Carefully trim Small Trailer Park sign from printed sheet, and glue to sign with white glue.



Main Entrance Sign

Glue mounting pins on bottom of Tree Trunks to openings in Tree Roots. Carefully trim Large Trailer Park sign from printed sheet and glue to completed trees with white glue.



Fence



Trim parts from sprues. If desired, carefully trim signs sign from printed sheet, and glue in place with white glue.

Camp Site Accessories

Camp Stools: Carefully bend braces in an X-shape as shown and apply a little glue where braces meet. Camp Tables: Carefully bend legs into position.

Fire Rings: Glue your choice of the Plain Hook or Hook with Cooking Pot to opening in Pit. Glue Pot to U-shaped handle. Trim mounting bases off small fence sections, cut to random lengths and glue over Fire pit to simulate logs. Kettles can be set nearby if desired.

Tables and Benches (13) can be used as desired; additional parts on this sprue may be kept for future projects or discarded.
