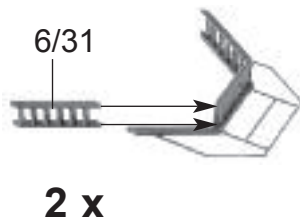


Crossover Walkways

Parts are provided to build two identical walkways as follows:

1) Note the raised ridge along one side of the Handrail & Support (6/30); use this to align the Platform (6/32) and glue in place at the center.



2) Glue the angled end of the Stairs (2x 6/31) to the left and right ends of the Platform, and glue the edge of the Stairs to the Support, using the ridge to align parts.

3) Note the small raised areas on the opposite side of the Handrail & Support; use these to align Braces (2x 6/33) and glue them to the support as shown



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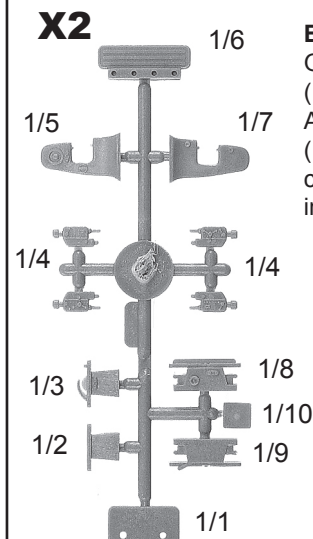
Thanks for purchasing this Walther's SceneMaster kit. All parts are styrene plastic so use compatible paint and glue to assemble and finish your model. Please take a few minutes to read these instructions and study the drawings before starting construction. PLEASE NOTE: Instructions are provided for items that require assembly, while others are add-on details that can be used as desired. All parts have two identification numbers to simplify locating specific items, for example on #7/22; the first identifies the sprue number (7) and the second (22) the part itself.

Machinery Assembly

Parts are provided to build two each of four different machines as follows:

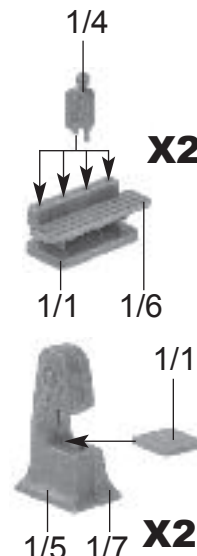
Drill Press:

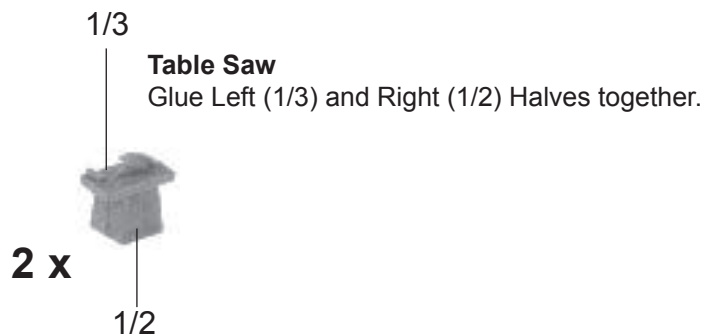
Align two large pins on underside of Table (1/6) with openings in Base (1/1) and glue together. Align small pins on back of Drills (4x 1/4) with openings at rear of Table and glue in place.



Band Saw:

Glue Left (1/5) and Right (1/7) Halves together. Align opening in Table (1/1) with small pin on completed saw and glue in place.



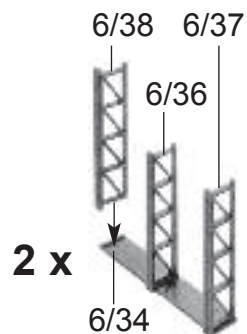


Jointer
Glue Left (1/8) and Right (1/9) Halves together.

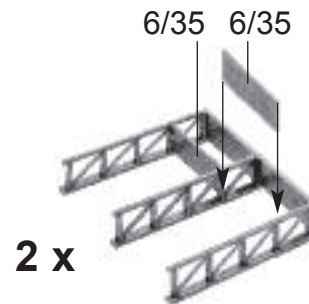


Metal Shelf Assembly

PLEASE NOTE: Parts are provided to build two identical sets of shelves as follows; the illustrations show four Shelves (6/35) installed, however you can easily customize your models to hold larger items by simply using fewer shelves.



1) The top of each Shelf Bracket (6/36/ 6/37 & 6/38) has a single tab; align the Top Shelf (6/34) in front of these tabs, with the Brackets resting in the raised ridges on the underside, and glue in place.



2) Carefully align the interior Shelves (6/35) with the cross members on each Bracket and glue where parts meet.
